
If you drill the holes into an object other than a stud, insert the wall plugs into the holes. Tap gently on the ends with a hammer until the wall plugs are flush with the wall.



Insert the screws into the holes and tighten the screws until only 6.5mm of the screws are exposed.



Align the wall mount holes on the baby unit with the screws on the wall. Slide the baby unit down until it locks into place.
